Fold up the page along the dotted line, so that the figures on the back side of the page show through the windows when the figures are folded outward. Help the students remember the Bible story using the pictures. Invite them to color the pictures. While doing this activity, review the memory verse.

Dear Parents:

Today your child learned about the celebration of Jesus' birth. We studied that God promised to send his Son Jesus, the Messiah. We celebrate his birth at Christmas. The Bible story told us about the visit that the angel Gabriel made to Mary to give her good news from God. She would be the mother of the only Son of God (Luke 1: 26-35, 38). During this week, talk with your child about God's love, and prepare him/her for the joy that Christmas brings.

Instructions: Help your students cut out both circles. Put one on top of the other, taking care that they are well aligned. The circle with the Bible verse must go on top of the one with the figures. Dear Parents:

Today your child learned about Joseph and Mary's journey to Bethlehem and Jesus' birth in the stable (Luke 21:1-7, 21). Tell your child that God loves them so much. That's why God sent Jesus, His only son. Remind them that Christmas is a special time that we celebrate and give thanks to God for Jesus' birth.



Instructions: Provide your students with figures of angels, shepherds and sheep from the Cut Out section. Tell them to color and cut them out. Then hand out the activity sheets and glue. Invite the children to reconstruct the Bible story, while placing the figures on the way to Bethlehem. Use the pictures that the children glue on the page, and ask them about the content of the story. For example: According to what we learned today, what did the shepherds do? (They left their sheep and went to look for the baby Jesus. They were very excited about what the angels had told them.)



Dear Parents:

Today your child learned about the joy of the shepherds when they heard the good news of the birth of the Messiah. They were so excited about what the angels had said that they went running to look for the baby Jesus (Luke 2:8-20). This week, celebrate Christmas with your child. Make a cake for Jesus and invite your child's friends to celebrate His birth. Remember to tell them the good news that Jesus is the Son of God!
